## Professor Alessandro Zerbi

Director of Pancreatic Surgery Unit, IRCCS Humanitas of Rozzano, Milan, Italy



Prof. Alessandro Zerbi is Director of pancreatic surgery in Humanitas. He is Full Professor in Surgery at the Humanitas University. He is member of several international surgical and pancreatological societies, among them the European Pancreatic Club (EPC), the European Neuroendocrine Tumor Society (ENETS), (IASGO) (IHPBA) and Italian Scientific Society (SIC), (ACOI), (SICO), (SICE). From 2015 to 2017 he was President of the Italian Association of Pancreatology (AISP).

His career developed at the San Raffaele Hospital, where in 2004 he became chief of the Pancreatic Surgery Unit. In 2010 he moved to Humanitas, to direct the Pancreatic Surgery Section. He is now one of the most experienced pancreatic surgeons all around Europe: he performed more than 1.300 pancreatic resections.

He developed specific expertise in multidisciplinary approach to pancreatic cancer, endocrine tumors, pancreatic cystic neoplasms, pancreatic metastases and duodenal tumors.

He was the first surgeon to perform islet cells autotransplantation combined to completion pancreatectomy in case of severe complications of pancreatoduodenectomy.

He is the author of the Italian Guidelines of acute pancreatitis and is a recognized leader opinion of this disease.

He currently coordinates the Screening Program for Familiar Pancreatic Cancer in Italy and the Italian Group for minimally invasive pancreatic surgery (IGoMIPS).

He is author of 170 peer reviewed scientific articles (H index: 43).
